



**DATE:** 18<sup>th</sup> August – 26<sup>th</sup> August 2011  
**LOCATION:** BELFAST NORTHERN IRELAND.  
**VENUE:** UNIVERSITY OF ULSTER; JORDANSTOWN CAMPUS

**ENTRY CRITERIA:** All participants must be members of the national official representative that is a member in good standing with CPISRA, with their membership for 2011 paid in full no later than February 1, 2011.

**COMPETITORS:** Minimum age for competition is 15 years old as of the first day of January 2011. Athletes must have been born before January 1, 1996.

**DIVISIONS OF PLAY:**

Individual BC1, BC2, BC3, BC4 and Pairs BC3, Pairs BC4 and Team competition.

5 competitors BC1, BC2; 3 competitors BC3; 3 competitors BC4

The maximum number of athletes in any individual event is three (3). The sum of BC1 and BC2 athletes should not exceed 5.

**RULES:** as set out by the Boccia Committee of CPISRA in the 10<sup>th</sup> edition of the rules.

**MAXIMUM NUMBER OF STAFF:** For the competitors the staff ratio is 1:1. As part of that it is allowed to enter 1 Coach for each Pair or Team category plus one overall team manager, i.e. a country has 7 athletes competing with 1 Team and 1 Pair BC3, this means that the maximum staff is 10.

Extra staff will be accepted under GUEST accreditation with NO access to the competition area. Apart from the regular entry fee, an extra fee of GBP£500 will also be charged for each extra staff. Extra rooms for extra staff can be arranged at a further charge.

**ACCOMMODATION:** Teams will be accommodated at the University Campus less than 800 metres from the Competition Site at the Sport Facilities. All rooms are single rooms. A second bed may be placed in some rooms. This will NOT reduce the cost per person. Teams must request this on the first entry form BUT there is no guarantee that this will be accommodated by the organising committee. Please indicate on the first entry form if you would like to request any rooms with a second bed and please specify the number. Of each type of room requested.

Additional days: Any request on accommodation for additional days must be requested through the entry forms in order to be considered. The cost for each extra day is GBP£100 per person breakfast included.

## TRANSPORT:

Transport will be provided only from and to the Belfast Airports. Teams arriving at the Dublin Airport will be charged an extra fee and cannot be guaranteed an adapted Bus.

To guarantee the transport from the airport to the University at arrival, it is essential that the transport form is completed with the entire information on flight times and numbers, together with exact details on additional equipment and number of wheelchairs, whether manual or electric, as well as other equipment as hoists, bath chairs or any other.

If no full information is received in due time referring transport from and to the Airport, the Organising Committee will have to charge an extra fee and cannot guarantee an adapted bus.

Please complete Transport Request Form and return it with the 2<sup>nd</sup> Entry Form.

## ENTRY FEE: GBP£1.305 per person.

Includes accommodation and all meals, from dinner on the 18<sup>th</sup> August until breakfast on the 26<sup>th</sup> August, social events and transport either from/to either Belfast Airports, applicable taxes and CPISRA competition capitation fees.

The cost per person for each extra day will be GBP£100 per person, including accommodation, breakfast and transport only from and to the airport. Lunch and dinner will be the teams responsibility.

## CRITICAL DEADLINES

In order to ensure sufficient services for participants, it is important that countries meet all deadlines. Teams will not be considered registered for the competition if a country fails to meet a deadline for submission of payment or information. Countries should email or fax the forms for entry in accordance with the following deadlines:

From 30 April up to 30 June, only ill or injured athletes may be replaced.  
Medical documentation is required for these cases.  
From the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 2<sup>nd</sup> entry, athlete substitutions are allowed.  
Only athletes from the same class can be substituted.
